Job requirements

- To provide expert coaching, feedback and analysis to players and coaches, with a primary focus on your area of technical specialty, to support the development of the technical and tactical skills required to succeed in high performance rugby.
- The candidate should hold or be committing to working towards there UKCC Level 3
- To be able to work within a coaching team and work within the framework created by the Head coach
- To work towards and meet the required standards of technical and tactical coaching to progress and to utilise CPD opportunities to further your knowledge.
- To utilise experience and techniques of the professional game, primarily in your area of technical specialty to drive coaching standards and best practices for players within the club.
- To work closely with Academies and clubs so that players individual development is being monitored and messages to the players are clear.
- Help identify potential players of Super 6 quality and work with local clubs to help build relationships and work with other coaches at local clubs to help develop them as coaches
