Ayr Rugby Super 6 Head Physiotherapist

Ayr Rugby club are looking for a Head Physiotherapist to work with the team in the new Super 6 competition for the 19/20 season. This is an exciting opportunity to work within a part-time professional environment in the inaugural Super Six competition. You will be highly motivated and well organised with a strong work-ethic, you will require excellent communication skills with players and the Head Coach. You will have a proven track record of good acute injury assessment and management skills; this role will require you to keep records that can be used to identify wider trends and help the team reduce injuries.

Working hours

The Head physiotherapist will be required to work Mon, Tue, Thur nights and match day (both home and away).

Job requirements

- Applicants are required to be Chartered Physiotherapists, be registered with the Health Care Professions Council and have in the region of 4 years' experience as a minimum.
- The physiotherapist must have experience of working within a sporting environment, preferably rugby.
- You will be required to pass and maintain a pitch-side first aid certificate equivalent to SCRUMCAPS if you do not already hold such.
- Technical excellence in the assessment, treatment and rehabilitation of injuries.
- An understanding of the requirement of medical staff working within a semi-professional sporting environment, and how to implement practices to help with prevention of injury and improving performance.
- We are looking for an individual who has good communication skills, and is used to working well within a team, but also may have some experience of leading and managing junior staff or students. The successful candidate will work with and be reportable to the Head coach.

Season Structure

The inaugural Super 6 competition, including cross border, with start in early November 2019 and end beginning of June 2020. There will be pre-season before the start of the domestic competition. More detailed information will be given at interview.
