Ayr Rugby Super 6 Team Manager

Ayr RFC are looking for a team manager to work within the team in the new Super Six competition for the 19/20 season. This is an exciting opportunity to work within a part-time professional environment in the inaugural Super Six competition. You will be highly motivated and well organised with a strong work-ethic, you will require excellent communication skills with players and team management. You will be comfortable using social media and communication apps, a good understanding of rugby along with its laws and regulations is preferable. You will require the ability to work independently and be resourceful.

Working hours

The team manager will be required to be available 2 nights a week and be willing and able to communicate with players during the day.

Job requirements

- Organise team travel- including cross border travel to Wales
- Co-ordinate training kit for match days and game day
- Communicate with players over training arrangements and match timings and club functions.
- Liaise with new players and help organise new players relocation needs
- Work with new players and clubs to obtain and transfer player registrations.
- Booking of training facilities
- Dress changing rooms on match days
- Point of contact for any player/coach appearance requests, this could include sponsor/community/club or media events
